Please note:

- (1) Any farmer who cannot attend an election meeting, may designate in writing an individual who is:
 - (a) not a farmer or a representative of a farmer and;
 - (b) a family member of the farmer to vote.
- (2) The Alternate Representative must reside in the district.
- (3) No such Alternate Representative shall have more than one vote nor represent more than one farmer.

CFO By-Law No. 26, Section 2.03(a) states:

Voting

For the purpose of electing farmer representatives to the District Chicken Farmers' Committee and eligibility for membership in a District Chicken Farmers' Committee or the Board, a farmer is the owner of a property on which chickens are produced other than a property rented to a tenant who produces and markets chickens on the tenant's own account, in which case the tenant, during the currency of the lease, is the farmer, and:

- (1) where the farmer is a corporation, the person, if any, designated in writing in respect of that property by the corporation shall be deemed to be the farmer. The person so designated, must reside in the district;
- (2) where the farmer is a firm or partnership or one or more persons carrying on the production and marketing under a trade name, farm name, or other designation, the person, if any, designed in writing in respect of the property by the owner or owners shall be deemed to be the farmer;
- (3) where the farmer is comprised of two or more persons who are joint owners, the one of such owners who first presents him or herself to register the vote in respect of the property shall be deemed to be the farmer;
- (4) no person shall have more than one vote and;
- (5) the farmer shall be eligible to vote only in the district where he or she resides.

CFO By-Law No. 26 Section 2.03(b) states:

Any farmer who cannot attend an election meeting, may designate in writing an individual who is:

- (1) not a farmer or representative of a farmer and who is
- (2) a family member of the farmer to vote.

No such alternative representative can have more than one vote nor represent more than one farmer.
