

General Regulation

WHAT is the regulation?

The regulation controls and regulates all aspects of producing and marketing chicken in Ontario.

WHO does the regulation apply to?

All chicken farmers, processors, custom processors, transporters, broker dealers, hatcheries, and any person in Ontario involved in the production and marketing of chicken.

WHERE does the regulation apply?

- Production and marketing of chicken
- Licensing as a farmer and processor
- Purchase and sale of chicken
- Receiving chicken
- Transporting and weighing chicken
- Payment to farmers
- Licence fees
- Hatchery, processor and custom processor information
- Books and records

WHAT are the implications to my operation if I don't comply with this regulation?

Chicken Farmers of Ontario may refuse to allot or increase quota, reduce or cancel quota that is allotted to a farmer, refuse to grant or renew or may suspend or revoke a processor or transporter licence or file a suit in a court of competent jurisdiction for any person who does not comply with or has contravened any provision of the Farm Products Marketing Act or Regulations, any plan, order or direction of The Ontario Farm Products Marketing Commission or any regulation, policy, order or direction of the Board.
