

Requirements for the Marketing of Chicken by Farmers to Out-Of-Province Processors Regulation

WHAT is the regulation?

The regulation controls and regulates the marketing of Ontario-produced chicken to processors located outside of the province.

WHO does the regulation apply to?

All operations and businesses involved in any aspect of marketing chicken from an Ontario farmer to an out-of-province processor.

WHERE does the regulation apply?

- Purchase and sale of chicken
- Receiving chicken
- Transporting and weighing chicken
- Payment to farmers
- Processor information
- Cancellation and non-fulfillment
- Furnishing of financial security

WHAT are the implications to my operation if I don't comply with this regulation?

Chicken Farmers of Ontario may refuse to allot quota, or reduce, refuse to increase, or cancel quota that is allotted to a farmer or revoke an out-of-province processors approval to purchase chicken produced in Ontario who does not comply with or has contravened any provision of the Farm Products Marketing Act or Regulations, any plan, order or direction of The Ontario Farm Products Marketing Commission or any regulation, policy, order or direction of the Board.
